SUMMARY OF POSITION/ POSITION DUTIES:

Currently we are seeking Entry Level Technicians with formal aircraft structures/sheet metal training. (Military and/or Approved Schools) Candidate should be enthusiastic and willing to learn. Candidates applying should be versed with blue print reading as well as use of specialty tools required for aircraft structural repair/assembly.

1. Reports to the Manufacturing Operations Manager and/or designee
2. Accomplish under direction all facets of aircraft sheet metal and structural repair, maintenance, modification, and component installation.
3. Disassemble, repair, and fabrication of structural items and mechanical assemblies.
4. Plan, lay-out, fabricate, and install structural mechanical modifications and/ or assemblies.
5. Have ability to interpret engineering drawings and task travelers.
6. Working knowledge of laying out hole patterns, drilling, riveting, hi-lok installations and removals, and use of all power tools necessary for performing the required tasks.
7. Accomplish assembly of mechanical assemblies per engineering drawings and task travelers.
8. Operate all power tools and equipment necessary to accomplish job assignments.
9. Fabricate, utilize, and maintain tooling drill jigs and assembly jigs.
10. Perform cutting, trimming, sanding, and installation of composite materials.
11. Utilize sealants, and anti-corrosion materials for applications on aluminum materials.
12. Work with heavy sheet metal performing different structural tasks such as pick-up holes and rework such as removing, replacing, or realigning ribs, longerons, bulkheads, stringers, fittings in completed skinned door and/ or pod assemblies.
13. Fabricate detailed parts such as shims, splices, gussets, angle brackets, doublers, stiffeners, and patches, as well as using shop aids to facilitate assembly and installation.
14. Flexible on differing work schedules and job duties based on company needs.

- Pending aircraft technicians license (S, M, E, or A&P) or documented experience in lieu of license.
